Job Purpose

The Senior Accountant will be responsible for preparing technical accounting analysis and consolidated financial data, including the preparation of monthly, quarterly, and annual reports. The ideal candidate will have strong analytical skills, a thorough knowledge of IFRS accounting principles, and an organized approach to ensure the timely delivery of accurate and useful financial reports.

Main Responsibilities

- Review the reasonability of monthly financial information submitted by [20] subsidiaries. Liaise with Mexico and Peru accounting teams to ensure financial information is accurate and complete.
- Prepare monthly consolidated financial statements and working papers.
- Assist in preparation of quarterly and annual consolidated financial statements.
- Assist in the coordination of the Company's quarterly reviews / annual audits.
- Document, maintain and strengthen internal controls over financial reporting (ICFR).
- Help maintain compliance with IFRS accounting standards and regulatory requirements across the organization, both for group reporting and statutory reporting.
- Identify areas for continuous improvement and efficiencies.
- Participate in other projects as required
